	<u>Groundworks</u>
	 TR confirmed that piling has now been completed and that groundworks have commenced Three cranes for blocks A, B and C are now in place Ground floor level slab expected to be completed within a week at blocks A and B, although dependent on weather conditions Substructure and ground floor slab works continue at Block C A Block D, groundworks have now commenced.

	Six Month Lock-Ahead
	 Block A: Concrete frame up to sixth floor Block B: Concrete frame completion Block C: Concrete frame up to level two Block D: Steel frame up to level four.



Note that this is anticipated progress, dependent on weather conditions and unforeseen issues.

Building Names

Following a consultation and poll held with estate residents in October 2023, all blocks have now been named – inspired by the former Metropolitan Cattle Market on site. The blocks are named after sheep breeds.

- Block A is Swaledale House
- Block B is Herdwick House
- Block C is Ryeland House
- Block D is Aberdale House.
